**SUBJECT: Notice of Possible Violation of Code of Student Conduct**

Dear Ms. Miller:

This office is investigating your possible violation(s) of the following section(s) of the Berkeley Campus Code of Student Conduct ("Code"):

V.102.16. Failure to identify oneself to, or comply with the directions of, a University official or other public official acting in the performance of his or her duties while on University property or at official University functions; or resisting or obstructing such University or other public officials in the performance of the attempt to perform their duties.

V.102.21. Violation of the conditions contained in the terms of a disciplinary action imposed under this Code or campus regulations.

This notice is based on information received by this office that alleges on or about February 17, 2010 you failed to comply with the conditions of your interim suspension by attending a forum at the Valley Life Sciences Building.

Please call this office at (510) 643-9069 by March 5, 2010 to schedule an appointment. The purpose of this meeting is to explain the disciplinary process to you, clarify the specifics of the incident, and review possible options for resolving this matter. **In order to prevent your future registration and/or student status from being blocked, you must contact the office by the date mentioned above.**

You should understand that this letter is a notice that a complaint has been made to this office. A complaint does not constitute a "charge" and may or may not lead to disciplinary action.


Effective August 28, 2009 through August 31, 2010 the timeline for case resolution outlined in the Code has been suspended. During this time, the timeline will serve as a guide for the resolution of cases.

Please be advised that under Section I.F of the Code, a student has the right to be accompanied by one advisor at any stage of the process at their own expense and to a hearing to resolve the issues outlined in this letter. Students are encouraged to fully participate in resolution of their case but may be assisted by an advisor who, with the written permission of the student, may interact directly with Student Conduct staff and may meet on behalf of the student to seek an informal resolution. A list of student rights under the Code has been enclosed with this letter.
