Steve,

This email serves as a response to your both your March 29, 2010 and March 30, 2010 letters. In your March 29 letter you make requests regarding a conduct hearing for Ms. Miller. Mike Smith has responded to your request around representation during a hearing. You also request an open hearing on Ms. Miller's behalf. To clarify a hearing date has not been scheduled yet. Associate Dean Christina Gonzales extended the time period for a hearing to be held until May 7, 2010. Once a hearing date has been scheduled and a Faculty Chair for the hearing confirmed; your request will be forwarded to the Faculty Chair for consideration and decision.

In your letter of March 30, you request that that correspondence not be included in Ms. Miller's conduct record. All exchanges and correspondence pertaining to a student's conduct case are maintained in the conduct record. You also offer an alternative informal resolution to Ms. Millers conduct cases. While I am certainly open to continued discussion around informal resolution; based on the information I have available to me regarding the incidents, the outcome you propose is not appropriate. If Ms. Miller has additional information she would like to share I would be glad to consider that as well as how it may impact the informal resolution I proposed in my March 10, 2010 letter.
