Dear Ms. Miller:

This responds to the request from your advisor Stephen Rosenbaum for reconsideration of the Interim Suspension issued to you in Vice Chancellor Le Grande's letter dated December 12, 2009 as upheld by the hearing panel on January 13, 2010.

After careful reconsideration I am modifying the interim suspension, until there has been a final determination of the alleged violations of the Code of Student Conduct.

You may only be on the Berkeley campus or other University property (including International House) for the sole purpose of attending your academic classes. You will be allowed a fifteen (15) minute window on either side of your class to enter and exit campus. Should you need additional accommodations to meet with faculty during office hours or other academic matters, please contact Susan Trageser for assistance. Be reminded that if you are on campus for reasons other than previously mentioned and without permission from Student Conduct and Community Standards, you will face additional action under the Code of Student Conduct.

While the interim suspension remains in effect, Cloyne Court is no longer considered a part of the restricted area.

The Center for Student Conduct and Community Standards is currently working on scheduling the hearing for resolution of your conduct case and will contact you as soon as a date has been identified.

Again, pending resolution of your conduct case regarding this matter I encourage you to take special care to adhere to the terms of the Interim Suspension in addition to campus rules and regulations. I would recommend that you consult with Susan Trageser in Student Conduct and Community Standards, should you need clarification on any of the above modifications.
