This responds to your March 15th letter. Your request that the case be dismissed is denied. Additionally you request that this office, or any of its staff, be recused from processing the case has been denied by the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs. The term "investigation and/or your admission" in the March 10th letter doesn't mean that Ms. Miller already admitted the alleged conduct but rather that she might admit to it by signing the letter and agreeing to the proposed disposition. Section II-A of the Code does not require furnishing the names of complaining witnesses. In any event, in this case there is no "complaining witness". The allegation that Ms. Miller attended a meeting on campus in violation of the terms of her interim suspension is based on my personal observation. Your 10 day extension request is granted. We look forward to your response to our proposal by April 9, 2010.
